

**INFORMATION NOTICE ON COLLECTION
AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**
*In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the
European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 ("GDPR")
on the protection of personal data.*

This information concerns the processing of personal data carried out in relation to participation in the openEHR Day, organized by CRS4 in collaboration with Sardegna Ricerche, Better by Marand, Inpeco and Dedalus (<http://www.crs4.it/it/news-view/il-crs4-organizza-il-primo-openehr-day-in-italia/>), including the shooting and dissemination of video footage. This information is used to indicate who treats your personal data for what purposes, in what ways and what are your rights as an interested party to the treatment.

Identity and contact details of the Data Controller

The Data Controller is CRS4 S.r.l. with headquarters in Pula (CA), loc. Piscina Manna, Building 1, e-mail INFO@CRS4.IT, PEC CRS4@LEGALMAIL.IT (hereinafter also referred as "Data Controller" or "CRS4").

Contact details of the Data Protection Officer ("DPO")

CRS4 has appointed a Data Protection Officer who can be contacted at the e-mail address dpo@crs4.it, or via phone, at the number +393931065076.

Categories of personal data and purpose of the processing

The processing of personal data acquired during events and public meetings related to the same, including your portrait and other personal data contained in the images and audio-video footage will be processed:

- for the video recording of the event and for the photographic reproductions, and their subsequent dissemination, for the purpose of dissemination of the event;
- to comply with obligations provided for by law, regulation or European legislation, to respond to specific requests from administrative or judicial authorities or to assert or defend a right of the CRS4, in the appropriate forums.

All the data listed above are stored in the servers of the CRS4, located in Pula, as well as on the servers of any external managers pursuant to art. 28 GDPR.

Methods of the processing

The processing of personal data for the above purposes takes place mainly by means of computer tools but, sometimes, may be subject to processing even without the aid of computer tools.

Legal basis of the processing

Personal data are processed by CRS4 on the basis of the execution of the obligations related to the organization of the event, and for the video-photographic documentation of the event, pursuant to and for the purposes of Articles 96 and 97 of Law 633/1941, since it is an event open to the public.

Optional nature of the contribution

The provision of data is optional. If the data is not provided, it will not be possible to use the images and/or audio-visual recordings of the person concerned for the purposes indicated above. If you wish to object to the processing of your image, please inform the Data Controller immediately by notifying the contact persons present at the event where the images are collected or by contacting the addresses indicated above.

Recipients or classes of recipients of personal data

The recipients of your personal data are:

- Employees and collaborators of CRS4, expressly designated and authorized to whom specific instructions have been provided. Authorized users have different levels of access, depending on their specific duties.
- The subjects identified as data controllers pursuant to Art. 28 of the GDPR. The data collected for registration will not be disclosed.

Your data, and in particular the images and videos taken during the event, may be disseminated on the websites of CRS4 and its organisational partners, as well as on their social channels (Facebook, Youtube, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn). Information on the processing of personal data, carried out by the social platforms where the images and videos are uploaded, are available on the websites of their respective operators.

Data transfer outside the European Union

Your personal data will be processed by CRS4 through its own IT tools located at its headquarters. Uploading videos to social platforms may result in a transfer outside the European Union, in which order you should consult the privacy information of their respective operators.

Data management and retention period

The data will be kept for the duration of the event and in any case for the time required by industry regulations for purposes related to the event

itself. The data relating to the video and photographic recordings of the event will remain on the website of CRS4 and its partners until your consent is revoked. However, this data may be retained for a longer period of time in order to establish liability in the event of a crime.

Rights of the data subject

As an interested party, according to the current regulations, you may exercise the following rights:

- request **access to your personal data and information** relating to the same, the **rectification** of inaccurate data or the **integration** of incomplete data, the **cancellation** of personal data concerning you (if one of the conditions indicated in art. 17, paragraph 1 of the GDPR occurs and in compliance with the exceptions provided for in paragraph 3 of the same article, for example if your data are processed unlawfully), the **limitation** of the processing of your personal data (if one of the hypotheses indicated in art. 18, paragraph 1 of the GDPR occurs, for example your data are processed unlawfully);
- **object** at any time to the processing of your personal data to the occurrence of special situations concerning you;
- exercise the **right to data portability**, i.e. the right to receive personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit such data to another controller, only in cases where the processing is based on consent and only for data processed by electronic means.

You can exercise such rights by contacting CRS4, via also the Data Protection Officer, at the above mentioned contact details.

You are also entitled, if you consider that the processing of personal data is in violation of the provisions of the European Regulation, to make a **complaint to a supervisory authority** (Authority for the protection of personal data - www.garanteprivacy.it), or **to file a complaint before the appropriate judicial authority**.

Automated decision-making, including profiling

Your personal data will not be subject to any automated decision-making process, including profiling.
