

# INFORMATION NOTICE ON COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 ("GDPR") on the protection of personal data.

This information concerns the processing of personal data carried out in relation to participation in the openEHR Day, organized by CRS4 in collaboration with Sardegna Ricerche, Better by Marand, Inpeco and Dedalus (http://www.crs4.it/it/news-view/il-crs4-organizza-il-primo-openehr-day-in-italia/). This information is used to indicate who treats your personal data for what purposes, in what ways and what are your rights as an interested party to the treatment.

## **Identity and contact details of the Data Controller**

The Data Controller is CRS4 S.r.l. with headquarters in Pula (CA), loc. Piscina Manna, Building 1, e-mail INFO@CRS4.IT, PEC CRS4@LEGALMAIL.IT (hereinafter also referred as "Data Controller" or "CRS4").

## Contact details of the Data Protection Officer ("DPO")

## Categories of personal data and purpose of the processing

Your personal data (name, surname, email address) sent through the registration form and/or obtained later, during the event or during public meeting related to the event, will be processed:

- for the registration to the event;
- to fulfil obligations under European law, regulation or legislation, to respond to specific requests from administrative or judicial authorities or to assert or defend a right of CRS4, in the appropriate fora

All the data listed above are stored in the servers of the CRS4, located in Pula, as well as on the servers of any external managers pursuant to art. 28 GDPR.

## Methods of the processing

The processing of personal data for the above purposes takes place mainly by means of computer tools but, sometimes, may be subject to processing even without the aid of computer tools.



## **Legal basis of the processing**

Personal data are processed by CRS4 on the basis of the execution of the obligations related to the organization of the event, and, by virtue of the express consent of the person concerned, for the purposes indicated above.

# Optional nature of the contribution

The user is free to provide the personal data requested at the time of registration, however, failure to provide the data indicated as necessary could make it impossible to participate in the event.

## Recipients or classes of recipients of personal data

The recipients of your personal data are:

- Employees and collaborators of CRS4, expressly designated and authorized to whom specific instructions have been provided. Authorized users have different levels of access, depending on their specific duties.
- The subjects identified as data processors pursuant to art. 28 GDPR, including eventbrite (www.eventbrite.it), through whose website you can register. The data collected for registration will not be disclosed.

## **Data transfer outside the European Union**

Your personal data will be processed by CRS4 through its own IT tools located at its headquarters. The registration process is managed by Eventbrite, which may transfer your data outside the European Union. In this case, the data is transferred on the basis of the adequacy decision called Privacy Shield (more information at https://www.eventbrite.it/support/articles/it/Troubleshooting/notifica-scudo-UE-USA-privacy?lg=en).

#### Data management and retention period

The data will be kept for the duration of the event and in any case for the time required by industry regulations for purposes related to the event itself. Such data could however be kept for a longer period, in order to ascertain responsibility in case of crimes.



## Rights of the Data Subject

As a Data Subject, according to the current regulations, you may exercise the following rights:

- request access to your personal data and information relating to
  the same, the rectification of inaccurate data or the integration of
  incomplete data, the cancellation of personal data concerning you
  (if one of the conditions indicated in art. 17, paragraph 1 of the GDPR
  occurs and in compliance with the exceptions provided for in
  paragraph 3 of the same article, for example if your data are
  processed unlawfully), the limitation of the processing of your
  personal data (if one of the hypotheses indicated in art. 18,
  paragraph 1 of the GDPR occurs, for example your data are
  processed unlawfully);
- **object** at any time to the processing of your personal data to the occurrence of special situations concerning you;
- exercise the right to data portability, i.e. the right to receive personal data in a structured, commonly used and machinereadable format and to transmit such data to another controller, only in cases where the processing is based on consent and only for data processed by electronic means.

You can exercise such rights by contacting CRS4, via also the Data protection officer, at the above mentioned contact details.

You are also entitled, if you consider that the processing of personal data is in violation of the provisions of the European Regulation, to make a **complaint to a supervisory authority** (Authority for the protection of personal data - www.garanteprivacy.it), or **to file a complaint before the appropriate judicial authority**.

## Automated decision-making, including profiling

Your personal data will not be subject to any automated decision-making process, including profiling.
